## Merit Badge Counseling

Scouts learn about sports, crafts, science, trades, business, and future careers as they earn merit badges, a critical component of advancement for the Star, Life and Eagle ranks. In keeping with tradition, all Troop 23 Scouts establish a foundation of outdoor skills, self-sufficiency, and active citizenship by earning their Scout, Tenderfoot, Second Class and First Class ranks before any work on Merit Badges.

The Merit Badge Counselor (MBC) is a key player in the Advancement Program. They offer time, knowledge, and other resources to give Scouts the opportunity to broaden their horizons. Combining fun with learning, an MBC is both teacher and mentor as the Scout learns by doing. MBCs must register as adult leaders and be approved by the Council Advancement Committee. MBCs do not pay a registration fee; but, those interested in becoming an MBC must complete (1) a BSA Adult Application for position code number 42, (2) the BSA Merit Badge Counselor Information Form, and (3) BSA Youth Protection Training. Some MBCs work with all Scouts; some work only in certain districts; and still others work with specific troops.

There are 137 merit badges offered by BSA. Seventeen are designated as Eagle Required Badges (underlined below). Scouts choose 13 of those plus at least 7 more. Troop 23 has 17 MBCs in place covering 52 different Merit Badges. Below are listed all the Merit Badges currently offered by Boy Scouts of America. The number in parentheses is the number of approved Troop 23-affiliated MBCs for the badge. Please review the list for badges that match your skills and interests. Ideally Troop 23 would have 3 to 4 MBCs for each Eagle-required badge and at least 1 for every other option.
