### CALLING ALL PRESENT AND FUTURE T23 YOUTH LEADERS:

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) is BSA's outdoor leadership experience geared toward both present and future youth leaders. Participants will be engaged in hands-on training that will cover the important topics and critical skills essential to leading within a unit, at school, and in life. Some say that the leadership training skills developed over the two weekends of camping are equivalent to a month of leadership experience in a typical unit. Troop 23 is inviting our Scouts ranked First Class and above to consider participating in this training opportunity. It will be offered by Three Fires Council at Camp Big Timber August 20-22 and August 27-29. Participants are required to attend both weekends to complete the course; must be at least 13 years of age; and, must have Scoutmaster Approval to attend.
