## **FINAL TROOP MEETING INFO:**

Our last meeting before Summer Camp is Monday, 6/14 from 7PM **TO** <u>8:30</u>. **PLEASE NOTE THE LATER END TIME**. There are no Troop Meetings after 6/14 until mid to late August when regular meetings will resume with our Fall Kick-Off Event.

Given the changes in our community's response to the improving pandemic conditions, Troop 23 has made the following changes to our in-person meeting protocols:

- Temperature checks will no longer be conducted at the beginning of each meeting.
- Masks will not be required at outdoor meetings and activities. Scouts and adults may opt to wear masks outside at their discretion.
- Masks <u>WILL</u> be required for all indoor activities. These indoor mask-required activities will include visits at the Advancement/Registration Table, the Uniform Exchange Cart, and the cave/storage space.

### **UPCOMING EVENTS:**

• UNIFORM EXCHANGE IS BACK! - JUNE 14 TROOP MEETING FROM 7:00-8:15:

At the June 14<sup>th</sup> troop meeting, bring items that you want to donate and receive a credit for each item. Class A and B clothing, boots, shoes, rain gear, camping gear, etc. that is in good condition will be accepted. You can also peruse the items available and pick up what you need. Items for sale range from \$1 up to \$20. Please bring cash (exact change will be appreciated if possible!). The exchange will close 15 minutes prior to the end of the troop meeting (8:15 p.m.).

Some additional notes on the Uniform Exchange:

- Scouts are welcome and encouraged to swap donated items with the Uniform Exchange. The "exchange rate" is one donated item for one used item of equal or lessor value.
- Donated items can only be exchanged for other donated items and not used for the purchase of new T23 Shirts or Sweatshirts.
- More than one item can be exchanged at a time; however, the items exchanged must be
  exchanged at the time of donation. With 60 Scouts we cannot keep track of previous donations.
  For example, if a Scout donates three items but takes only one item in exchange, the remaining
  two items are a donation to the Uniform Exchange. I owe yous (IOUs) will not be issued for past
  donations to be put toward future purchases.
- Damaged items cannot be swapped back into the Uniform Exchange.

#### **HEALTH FORMS UPDATE:**

- All Continuing Scouts those going to Summer Camp AND those NOT going to Summer Camp should turn in new health forms (Parts A and B with a copy of your current health insurance card). They expire after 1 year and our goal is to have all our Scouts on roughly the same schedule with providing new health forms in the Spring.
- Additional Form For Scouts Going To Summer Camp Scouts going to Summer Camp must
  also have a current Part C filled out and signed by the Scout's physician on file; <u>but not all Scouts
  need a new one</u>. Because of our July timing of Summer Camp last year and Part Cs being valid
  until the last day of the month they're dated, many Scouts will not need a new part C for Summer
  Camp this year. Please click <u>T23 Scout Part Cs</u> to determine your Scout's specific needs for part
