DUE 9/13/12 - 2022 CONSENT FORM, HEALTH FORMS, DUES, AND PROGRAM FEES:

Troop 23 families should have received an e-mail regarding forms and fees for next year. **Please note annual fees for Troop 23 are increasing this year by \$25 to total \$375.** We will collect these annual fees in two parts -- \$150 in Dues and \$225 in Program Fees. Dues are largely a pass-through to Three Fires and Boy Scouts of America, while Program Fees fund Troop 23. Program Fees can be waived if Scouts sell a minimum wreath sale fundraising level. Details on that will be shared in upcoming communications regarding 2021 fundraising.

This year, Dues and Consent Forms are being collected a few months earlier than usual because Three Fires has revised its re-chartering years from January-December to November-October. Program Fees will continue to be collected in late December or early January depending on when final fundraising results become available.

In addition, a significant number of Scouts need to turn in new health forms. Typically, all Scouts who attended Summer Camp would be current with health forms; however, the July timing of Summer Camp in 2020 allowed many Scouts to use their 2020 Health Forms for Summer Camp 2021. The email you will receive regarding 2022 Forms and Fees will let you know if new health forms are needed for your Scout.

All Scouts looking to be a part of Troop 23 in 2022 must submit the 2022 Consent Form, current Health Forms (if not already on file), and \$150 in Dues to the Registration Table at the next troop meeting on Monday, September 13, 2021 in order to be included on the official Troop 23 roster. Dues can be paid by cash, check, or Scout Account funds.
