2021 Summer Camp Parent Information

- We are attending Camp Freeland Leslie (CFL) summer camp in 2021 (June 20-26), in Oxford Wisconsin. This camp is just over 3 hours away.
- The troop needs to know every person who intends to spend all or part of the week at CFL. If you intend to visit camp, you MUST pre-register according to the deadlines below. Note that you will be required to pay fees and may be required to provide your own lodging.
- There will be a Summer Camp Information Meeting. Please watch Hot News for the date of the meeting.
- Early registration and final registration deadlines are firm. A late fee is charged by the camp if early registration date is not met.
- Health forms ABB&C must be signed by a doctor and dated after June 1, 2020. <u>Provide 3 complete</u> copies of health forms. PLEASE DO NOT PRINT ANY OF THE DOCUMENTS DOUBLE SIDED.
 Please also keep a copy for yourself as well! <u>Be sure to include a copy of your insurance card, front</u> and back, with each health form again please do not print insurance card double sided either.
- Parents please accompany Scouts to turn in paperwork. In case there are questions, missing signatures, or additional information needed, we want to handle issues with the parents immediately.
- Merit Badges are typically Scouts who are First Class or higher, however there may be exceptions. Mr. Jeffers must sign all Blue Cards <u>before</u> you sign up for MB's. Show your completed Blue Cards to the Summer Camp team and take your Blue Cards to camp. If you are taking MB's for the first time, read the MB Guide on the Troop's website for info and recommendations. The MB schedule is will be available through the Troop's website. Note that some MB's have age and rank requirements, some have additional fees, and some require prerequisites. We will charge merit badge fees to your son's scout account - please make sure your scout's account remains funded. There is a chance that some MB's will fill up quickly. If your son is dropped from a MB, we will ask him to choose a new MB.

Summer Camp 2021 CHECKLIST

Turn in all forms and fees to the Summer Camp Coordinators One form is required for every Scout and Leader attending camp

➢ <u>April 12</u>:

- \$300 camp fees due, late fees apply and are charged by the camp after this date unless a crossover scout
- Completed Registration Form
- □ Completed Merit Badge schedule & special program sign-ups
- Blue Cards—get Scoutmaster's signature, show to Camp Coordinator, take with you to Camp!

It is your responsibility to turn in the health forms by May 24th at the latest. Please aim to turn them in sooner in case adjustments need to be made. If you do not turn in the forms, your son cannot attend camp. With over 500 pages of forms to collect, Summer Camp Coordinators cannot chase down missing forms. This is your responsibility. **Make doctor appointments today**.

May 24 (earlier is much appreciated):

- BSA Annual Health and Medical Record Parts, A, B & C
 YOUR HEALTH FORMS MUST BE TURNED IN BY MAY 24th at the latest and must be dated June 1, 2020 or later. We ask that you double-check the following before handing in:
 - Make 4 complete copies -- 3 to turn in and 1 for your records. PLEASE DO NOT DOUBLE SIDE
 - Include a COPY OF BOTH SIDES OF YOUR HEALTH INSURANCE CARDS again please do not print double sided
 - Part A
 - 1) DO NOT check the box beside "Checking this box indicates you DO NOT want your child to use a BB device" unless you want your Scout to be EXCLUDED from participating in activities using BB guns or other BB devices
 - 2) Mark the box beside "None" if there are no restrictions (or write in restrictions)
 - 3) Be sure BOTH parent and Scout have signed and dated in the box in the center of the page
 - Part B, Side 2—Allergy/Medications
 - 1) Indicate if your son uses an Epi Pen or Asthma Rescue Inhaler
 - 2) List all medications your son routinely takes, OR check the box to indicate "no medications routinely taken"
 - 3) Check "yes" if you authorize the Troop to administer over-the-counter meds like ibuprofen, Tylenol, Benadryl, etc if needed, and
 - 4) Provide the parent/guardian signature needed for that section
 - Part B, Side 2—Immunization
 - 1) Provide the exact date of the last tetanus shot (Tdap)
 - 2) Fill in immunization dates or write "up to date" and attach an immunization record from doctor
 - Part C
 - 1) Be sure it's signed and dated by doctor
 - 2) Be sure doctor's address is provided
 - Staple completed sets in this order—Part A, <u>Part B/Health History page, Part</u> B/Allergies/Medications, Part C, additional pages from doctor, insurance card copies
- Attend Summer Camp Parents Meeting date to be announced.
