SERVICE OPPORTUNITY:

We will be partnering with Three Fires Council with their Scouting For Food Campaign. Each scout will be receiving 5 door hangers at our meeting this coming Monday, March 3rd. They will be responsible for hanging the door hangers within their neighborhood. Timeline is as follows:

- March 3: Scouts receive 5 door hangers
- March 4-9: Scouts put 5 door hangers on the doors of houses in their neighborhood
- March 15: Scouts pick up bags of food from the 5 houses beginning at noon. PLEASE NOTE: If food is not picked
 up by 4PM Mrs. MacKinnon will be getting direct text messages and/or phone calls from your neighbors. Please
 pick up the bags of food on time.
- March 17: Scouts bring collected food to the scout meeting. Food will be sorted and counted. Numbers need to be shared with Three Fires Council. Then food will be loaded into Mrs. MacKinnon's vehicle and brought to Milton Township Food Pantry.

Scouts will receive 1 hour of service. Please contact Mrs. MacKinnon if you have any questions.
