MERIT BADGE DEADLINE 3/10:

The cutoff for merit badges for Court of Honor is Monday 3/10/25. Blue cards for merit badge university should now be posted in the Three Fires Council portal. In order to access those; 1) log in, 2) click on name in the upper right, 3) view activity, 4) look for Merit Badge University, 4) select "Blue cards, plain paper", 5) preview report, 6) print and bring to next meeting, or save as pdf and email to Mr Johnson at paulijohns@gmail.com. Incomplete merit badges will still need to be recorded, so we can get that progress into Troop Master.

SERVICE OPPORTUNITY:

 neighbors. Please pick up the bags of food on time.
- Mon., March 17: Scouts bring collected food to the scout meeting. Food will be sorted and counted. Numbers need
 to be shared with Three Fires Council. Then food will be loaded into Mrs. MacKinnon's vehicle and brought to
 Milton Township Food Pantry.
