ANNUAL SWIM TEST:

Our annual Swim Test is Sunday April 19, anytime between 12-2 pm. Wheaton Sport Center is graciously accommodating us again. As we get closer, we'll send out an email with their permission slip and more info. This applies for the First Class requirement as well as any other aquatic activities, including Summer Camp attendees. Summer camp attendees who can't make it to this test time will need to take their test upon arrival at Summer Camp.

SAFEGUARDING YOUTH TRAINING FOR ADULT VOLUNTEERS:

All adults volunteering/participating in any Scouting activities must complete the Safeguarding Youth Training (formerly known as Youth Protection Training), or SYT. Most adults training certification expires May 31st (after National shortened the applicable period to shift to the new, improved SYT). SYT must be completed and current in order to participate in any Scouting activities. Subsequent annual recertification should be shorter in following years.
