HEALTH FORMS NEEDED FOR SUMMER CAMP

All Scouts and adults attending Camp Tomahawk must submit current health forms and copies of both sides of their health insurance card to the Troop. Forms must be dated after June 1, 2025. Access the forms here: [\[link\]](#) Everyone needs parts, A, B1, and B1. Anyone staying three or more nights must complete Part C, which requires a physician's signature - please schedule appointments early. We ask that you submit three single-sided copies of the completed forms and three copies of both sides of the insurance card at a Monday night Troop Meeting as soon as possible. SAFEGUARDING YOUTH TRAINING FOR ADULT VOLUNTEERS:

All adults volunteering/participating in any Scouting activities must complete the Safeguarding Youth Training (formerly known as Youth Protection Training), or SYT. Most adults training certification expires May 31st (after National shortened the applicable period to shift to the new, improved SYT). SYT must be completed and current in order to participate in any Scouting activities. Subsequent annual recertification should be shorter in following years. WHEATON MEMORIAL DAY PARADE - MAY 25TH:

Scouts will meet at the church at 7:30 AM to prepare for the morning parade, which will conclude at Wheaton Cemetery and be followed by a ceremony. A family picnic at the church will take place immediately afterward. An RSVP and sign-up for the picnic will be distributed at a later date.

All Scouts are expected to participate in the parade unless they have a conflicting commitment, such as participation in a marching band. Nearby parking is available, including at Edison Middle School, for those who plan to drive or arrange carpools for return transportation.
