Submissions for all requirements will be accepted through October 15th. From October 16th through December 1st, only a limited number of requirements will be accepted for submission. Please be sure to submit completed requirements by the applicable deadline.

SCOUT DUES:

You may have received an email from Scouting America regarding membership renewal. National sends these notices approximately two months before a Scout's membership expires. Annual dues for the 2026–2027 Scout year are \$175 per Scout and are due by September 21st. These dues help support the national and council Scouting organizations. A subscription to *Scouting* magazine is optional and costs an additional \$15.

Dues can be paid through the Troop by Zelle at troop23camps@gmail.com, check payable to BSA Troop 23, cash, or using the Scout's Scout Account. Mr. Smith will also accept payments at Troop meetings.

These dues are the same membership renewal fees referenced in the email you may have received from Scouting America. If you pay through the Troop rather than directly to Scouting America, the Troop will take care of the membership renewal on your behalf, and you will not have to pay a credit card processing fee.

We do not want financial concerns to prevent any Scout from participating in the Scouting program. If the membership dues are a financial difficulty for your family, please contact Ed Smith confidentially to discuss available assistance. If your Scout does not wish to continue with Scouting, please let Mr. Smith know.

ADULT DUES:

Adult registration dues of \$77 are paid by the Troop. To complete the Troop's registration for the 2026–2027 Scout year, all adult leaders must have current Safeguarding Youth Training (SYT), formerly known as Youth Protection Training (YPT), through November 1, 2026.

If your SYT expires before November 1st, please complete the required training before September 21st so we can process the Troop's registration renewal on time. You can check your current SYT expiration date by logging into your [my.Scouting.org](https://my.scouting.org) account.

TROOP PROGRAM FEE:

The Committee lowered the annual Troop program fee to \$350 for the 2026-2027 Scouting year. The Troop typically collects this in late fall as our wreath sale fundraiser ends, and Scout Accounts are credited.
